# Extract from the Terms of Participation A and B

## **A 4 Co-exhibitors and additionally represented companies**

A co-exhibitor is one who presents his own goods or services, using his own staff, at the stand of another exhibitor (the main exhibitor). This definition includes group companies and subsidiaries. Agents and representatives are not admitted as co-exhibitors.

In the case of an exhibitor who is also a manufacturer, an additionally represented company is any other company whose goods or services are offered by the exhibitor.

If an exhibitor who is a distributor displays not only the products of one manufacturer but also goods and services of other companies, then these count as additionally represented companies.

Admission of the exhibitor does not mean that a contract exists between MMI and the co-exhibitors or other companies he represents. Co-exhibitors are admitted against payment. This also applies to additionally represented companies if specified in the Special Terms of Participation B. The exhibitor must make this payment.

The amount can also be invoiced subsequently by MMI.

The exhibitor is responsible for ensuring that his co-exhibitors and other companies he represents comply with the Terms of Participation A and B, the Technical Guidelines as well as the instructions of the Trade Fair Management.

The exhibitor is liable for the debts and negligence of his co-exhibitors or additionally represented companies as if they were his own. If co-exhibitors make direct use of MMI services, MMI is entitled to invoice the exhibitor for these services. He is jointly and severally liable.

The exhibitor may not move, exchange or share his stand, nor surrender it either in part or in whole to third parties, without MMI's prior written consent.

## **B 3 Co-exhibitors (see A 1/2/4)**

Permission for co-exhibitors must be requested in writing. The registration fee is USD 200 for each co-exhibitor admitted.
